WHEREAS, both parties recognize the benefits of collaboration and mutual support in achieving their goals;

Now, Therefore, in consideration of the mutual benefits to be derived from this collaboration, the parties agree as follows:

Purpose and Scope

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a framework for collaboration between Birpara College and Harit Peer Review Journal in the areas of academic research, publication, and innovation.

Areas of Collaboration

The parties agree to collaborate in the following areas:

- Academic research: joint research projects, seminars, and workshops
- **Publication:** publication of research papers and articles in Harit Peer Review Journal
- **Innovation:** joint innovation projects, entrepreneurship, and start-up initiatives

Implementation and Coordination

The parties agree to establish a joint committee to oversee the implementation of this MoU. The committee shall comprise representatives from both parties and shall meet regularly to discuss progress, plan new initiatives, and resolve any issues that may arise.

Financial Arrangements

The parties agree to share the costs of joint activities and programmes, as mutually agreed upon.

Intellectual Property Rights

The parties agree to respect each other's intellectual property rights and to

Duration and Termination

This MoU shall come into effect on the date of signing and shall remain in force for a period of five years. Either party may terminate this MoU by giving written notice to the other party three (03) months prior to the intended date of termination.

Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising out of this MoU shall be resolved through mutual consultation and negotiation. If the dispute cannot be resolved through negotiation, it shall be referred to arbitration in accordance with the laws of India.
