- 2. Do you agree with the view that Charudatta in *Mrchhakatika* is different from the usual heroes of Sanskrit plays? Justify your answer.
- 3. Would you consider *Swami and Friends* as a specimen of children's literature? Give reasons for your answer.
- 4. Do you think that as a protagonist of *In Custody*, Deven is depicted negatively and grotesquely? Argue your answer.

- 5. Assess 'My Grandmother's House' as a memory poem.
- 6. What reflection of Indianness do you get in Ezekiel's poetry? Explain with reference to the poems on your syllabus.
- 7. What light does 'The Intrusion' throw on matrimony in contemporary Indian society?
- 8. Is it correct to say that underneath a mere domestic conflict, 'The Two Lady Rams' actually engages with the theme of the colonial master vis-à-vis the colonial subject? Elucidate.

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
