- 1. How far is it true to say that the Mystery, Morality and Miracle plays as well as the Interludes heralded the drama proper in England? Argue your answer.
- 2. Critically assess the contributions of Cædmon and Cynewulf to the development of Old English Christian poetry.
- 3. Do you agree with the view that the development of Old English prose does not go back in earlier Germanic origins but takes place wholly in England? Discuss.
- 4. Give an account of Old English Heroic Poetry mentioning some of the important texts that fall in this category.

#### **GROUP-B**

- 5. Examine the blend of pagan and Christian elements in *Beowulf*.
- 6. In what sense is 'The Wife of Bath's Prologue' dramatic? Explain.
- 7. Comment on Chaucer's portrayal of pilgrims from a diverse cross-section of society with reference to the 'General Prologue' to *The Canterbury Tales*.
- 8. What is the role of women in the heroic culture of *Beowulf*?

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
