- 2. 'Tintern Abbey' is a poem concerned with the function of memory as a means of regeneration and self-knowledge. Discuss.
- 3. How does Byron glorify the ideals of liberty in 'On the Castle of Chillon'?
- 4. Examine 'Kubla Khan' as a poem dealing with the process of artistic creativity.
- 5. How does Keats combine the natural, the animal and the human worlds in his poems? Elucidate using examples from his poems included in your syllabus.
- 6. Elaborate on the mythopoeic element in the poetry of Shelley with special reference to 'Ode to the West Wind'.

- 7. The Monster, not Victor, is the real hero of *Frankenstein*. Do you agree? Give reasons for your answer.
- 8. Comment on the Gothic elements found in *Frankenstein*.
