The first session of the workshop on “Leave Rules, Service Book and Related Issues” organised by IQAC, Birpara College was held in the Department of Geography on Thursday, March 10, 2022, from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.

Aims of the Workshop

The workshop, which will be conducted over a number of sessions, has been planned to make the newly appointed teaching faculty aware of their roles and responsibilities as defined in their terms of service. The resource persons at the workshop, all drawn from the college itself, will also help ensure that the service books of all teaching faculty in substantive posts are kept up to date.

Report on the First Session

Two senior teachers from Birpara College, Sri Subrata Sengupta and Sri Dipankar Bhaumik, both Associate Professors in the Department of Commerce, conducted the session in the presence of Teacher-in-Charge, Dr. Dil Kumar Pradhan and Coordinator, IQAC, Dr. Nikhilesh Bhattacharya. In total, eight other teachers participated in the session. Sri Sengupta presented an overview of the service rules that govern the employment of faculty members in substantive posts in government-aided colleges like Birpara College, spoke of the importance of keeping one’s service book up to date and handed each participant a list of important documents related to their appointment and service. Sri Sengupta and Sri Bhaumik also shared some of their own experience regarding the subject.

The session ended with a question-and-answer session where the resource persons responded to various queries from the participants.
