

An introductory note on the eve of the inaugural function :

4th December, 1986.

We welcome our guests and express all our sincere gratitude to them for having found time to attend this noble occasion.

Birpara, you know, being an integral part of the Dooars Region, has always been important for its tea, forests and mines. Strategic reasons are also there. Like all other people of the State, we would also like to see our people enjoying a better earning and better life.

But in reality, people here, in general, are poor, helplessly timid, parochial in their outlook. These obsessions could be eradicated only by a rational spread of education. Though there is no significant dearth of imparting Secondary education in our area, scope for availing higher education, till this date, is an uncomfortable luxury.

So when on 9th August, Prof. Nirmal Bose, Minister-in-charge, Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal, called on us at the Circuit House in Jalpaiguri and offered his help and support for establishing a Degree College at Birpara, we relished the idea. But we are to provide land, building and a reserve fund of Rs. 1.5 lakh. We know that materialisation of these tasks are too hard to tackle.

Some years ago, you know, an unsuccessful attempt was made to establish a college at Birpara. But people here did not like to accept this endeavour euphemistically. We had this painful experience in our mind and we feared that people would not forgive us if we failed this year too. Actually we were in an impasse.

Since we could not deny... .

Since we could not deny the scope for higher education in our area and our responsibility to help extend the cause, we assembled on 22nd August at the Birpara Dhamasala. A committee was formed. From 28th August, we have launched a massive drive for raising funds. Thanks to Sri Sunil Mitra, I.A.S., formerly the D.M. of Jalpaiguri, who helped us much in providing the required quantum of land and settling the same with us in the name of the Birpara College. Thereafter we appealed to our friends, tradesmen, tea-planters. Very few kept away from us, but most of the people looked to our problem unitedly and extended their co-operating hands.

On 2nd September, we met Dr. A. Chatterjee, I.A.S., Edn. Secretary, Govt. of West Bengal. We were confident then that we would be able to fulfil the conditions laid down on us. The construction of the college house had already been started with speedy progress but it met with an unwanted halt due to a sudden out-burst of secessionist trouble. Even the district administrative authorities asked us to suspend our work for an indefinite period.

Meanwhile we approached the University authorities. To obtain the Govt. sanction of a college, you know, involves a very cumbrous process. We insisted the university authorities on their early visit. The Puja vacation intervened. On 13th November an Inspection team headed by Dr. A.K. Sinha, Inspector of Colleges and Prof. N.C. Bhowmick, Principal, A.C. Commerce College, visited Birpara College and submitted their report on 18th November, conveying a good support.

Thus we have completed.....

Thus we have completed a steep journey but we are late. A question arose whether we would get sanction from this academic session.

We were disturbed too. Equally we would like to mention the mischievous attitude of some of the scandal mongers like UTTAR DAR PAN & BHARAT KATHA which deliberately aimed at disgracing Prof. Bose and our endeavour by publishing got up news in the name of journalism. It is good, people in general care very little of such got up news item.

We would be failing in our duties if we omit to record with immense gratitude the name of Prof. Bose from whom we got unstinted support. Without his help it would be practically impossible to start this college from the current academic session and obtain necessary Govt. sanction.

Equally we would cherish co-operation and timely advice from Sri N.Bhattacherjee, Minister-in-charge, Irrigation and Waterways, Sri N.Bhowmick, Principal, Commerce College and Prof. D.B.Dutta, Vice-Chancellor, North Bengal University and Prof. Bajpai, Registrar, North Bengal University.

It would be an act of ingratitude if we do not mention the name of Dr. A.K.Chatterjee, Edn. Secretary, Sri S.Sen, Deputy Secretary, Govt. of West Bengal, Sri G.D.Gautam, I.A.S., D.M., Jalpaiguri, who helped us much in solving different problems.

A seed is shown. Let us wait for a fully bloomed tree. We can expect that this new born institution will be a great centre of learning in the years to come. What we are to do is to save it from all hazards.


